



## **Watertown City School District DISTINGUISHED ALUMNI HALL OF ACHIEVEMENT**

### **OBJECTIVE**

To recognize and celebrate the achievements of Watertown High School graduates by honoring those who have attained a high level of distinction in their lives and provide positive role models for students of the district.

### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

This program will honor Watertown High School graduates\* for demonstrating:

An outstanding and unique contribution or level of service to their community, profession or other good cause whether it be at the local, regional, national, or international level.

The nominee must have graduated from Watertown High School at least ten (10) years prior to nomination (Class of 1999 would be latest year eligible). Candidates must also represent a positive role model to students in the school district.

*\*For candidates attending Watertown City Schools from 1865-1945, the graduation requirement may be waived.*

### **NOMINATION PROCESS**

Anyone may nominate a graduate for this distinction, except the individual himself/herself. A deceased graduate may be nominated. Information regarding the process will appear in the local media, the WCSD web site, and letters to faculty. Nomination forms will be available at the WCSD District Office, 1351 Washington Street, P.O. Box 586, Watertown, NY 13601.

Individuals who submitted nomination forms for the 2005 induction need not complete another nomination form. A letter simply renominating the person is sufficient. If there is additional information you would want added to the 2005 nomination form, include it in your renomination letter.
